
DIRECT RESTORATION



AKA 'A FILLING'

COMPOSITE/ AMALGAM A direct restoration is the use of a material such as Composite (white filling) or Amalgam (metal coloured filling) to restore a tooth back to its normal function after removal of unhealthy tooth tissue due to decay or loss of enamel from tooth wear. This procedure is carried out usually in a single appointment by the dentist.
